Legislative Update by Mike Dillon

As the "No Surprises Act's" ban on balance-billing continues to face legal challenges, a recent survey found the new consumer protections prevented over 2 million potential surprise medical bills so far in 2022.

Senate Finance Committee Chair Ron Wyden (D-OR), Ranking Member Mike Crapo (R-ID), Senator Ben Cardin (D-MD) and Senator John Thune (R-SD) released a discussion draft for telehealth policies to improve healthcare across the nation.

Millions of Medicaid beneficiaries will be "unwinding" over the next several months as the public health emergency comes to an end. It is still unclear as to how people currently covered under will continue to be covered.

Name Change May Occur In Austin

The Annual NAHU National Convention will be held in Austin, Texas on the dates of June 25 - 28.

A vote will be taken to change NAHU, the National Organization of Health Underwriters, to NABIP - the National Association of Benefits and Insurance Professionals.



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
