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New By-Laws For NNAHU

The Northern Nevada National Association of Health Underwriters will soon undergo an historical change as it evolves into the National Association of Benefit and Insurance Professionals – Northern Nevada.



On May 10th, the Annual Membership Meeting of NNAHU will be held at the Atlantis Casino and Resort. The meeting will start at 11:30 AM before the beginning of the luncheon.

There will be a vote to approve or reject a series of By-Law Amendments mostly related to the national organization's recent name change. If approved, the new By-Laws will give our chapter the name of "National Association of Benefits and Insurance Professionals – Northern Nevada (NABIP-NN)".

Other amendments to be voted upon involve a simplification of rules covering the regulations and auditing of the chapter's financials, the renumbering of some current sections of the By-Laws, the addition of a list of the NABIP Code of Ethics and the rewriting of various grammatical and typographic corrections.

NNAHU President Mike Dillon will lead a delegation of five other officers to the 2023 NABIP Capitol Conference in Washington DC at the end of this month.

NABIP Capitol Conference is slated to be the first one in 3 years during which attendees will be able to meet face to face with lawmakers.

New Insurance Commissioner On Tap ... But Who?

With the election of Republican Joe Lombardo as Governor, Democratic appointee Barbara Richardson, resigned as expected from her position as the Nevada Insurance Commissioner.

Nick Stosic, DOI Deputy Commissioner, well known to NNAHU and frequent lunch speaker at the chapter's monthly membership meetings, was appointed the Interim Commissioner.

Since the position of Commissioner is appointed by the Governor, Lombardo will select the next head of the department.

Along with Stosic, another possible appointment is Scott Kipper, a former Nevada Insurance Commissioner, who is well known to chapter members as he has lived and worked in the Reno area for years.

Membership Luncheon Prices To Increase

After getting bids from other possible venues for the monthly membership luncheons, the chapter's Board of Directors determined that the Atlantis was still the best value available, even though their food costs will necessitate an increase in menu prices.

Luncheon costs will increase by \$5 effective in March.



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
